### Functional Role:

The Adaptive Alpine Race and Free Ride Coach delivers instructional and competitive adaptive alpine race and free-ride programs to participants and athletes of the Whistler Adaptive Sports Program.

### Duties:

#### Operational:

- Instruct and/or coach individuals, groups, and children with physical, cognitive and sensory disabilities in adaptive freeride and competitive alpine race programs.
- Work cooperatively with volunteers to deliver community adaptive alpine race and freeride programming.
- Work collaboratively with Whistler Adaptive core staff.
- Ensure a safe and inviting environment for activity participants and athletes.
- Adhere to safe operating procedures in a snow sport environment.
- Foster a strong culture of health and safety; work with core Whistler Adaptive staff to ensure that all WorkSafeBC requirements are met.
- Knowledge of Whistler Adaptive product and services to assist promotion and cross-promotion when interacting with guests and athletes.
- Interact with volunteers to ensure their inclusion in the Adaptive Alpine Race and Freeride Program.

#### Administration:

- Maintain individual/group attendance and progress records.
- Plan training sessions and complete competition entries.

## Key Competencies:

- Experienced and skilled skier and/or snowboarder.
- Passion for adaptive sport and making a difference in our community.
- Ability to work independently as well as part of a team.
- Strong customer service skills and ability to work with individuals of all ages and their families.
- Satisfactory criminal record check is mandatory prior to commencement of employment.
- Current OFA Level 1 or higher first aid certification is preferred Whistler Adaptive will provide funding for ongoing professional development, training and certification upgrades for the successful candidate as well as mentorship opportunities with our current swim instructor.
- Ability to safely instruct and coach athletes with a disability from on the Long-Term Athlete Development Pathway from Fundamentals to Learn to Train.

- One or more of the following certifications is required:
  - Canadian Association for Disabled Snowsports (CADS) Level 1 or higher certification.

  - Special Olympics Competition Sport Coaching Certification.
  - Special Olympics Community Stream Workshop.
  - CSIA Level 2.
  - Or equivalent international experience and/or certification.
