Summary

8,646 total program lessons delivered over 3 years

- o An average increase of 18.5% from 2018 levels
- o Translates to approximately 31,296 program hours

We welcomed 634 unique participants and 10 partner organizations

- o The median number for all our participants was 3
- o Each year we welcomed new participants who had never played with us
- o The most active partners were the District of Squamish and Solider On

Our participants love what we do

- o Overall equipment and lesson satisfaction remains high
- o Appreciation for our volunteers was expressed at every opportunity
- o Participants feel safe, accommodated and families praise the experience

Super Users continue to thrive with us

- o These participants used a minimum of 100 and as many as 539 lessons
- o On average, Super Users participate 1.4 times per week

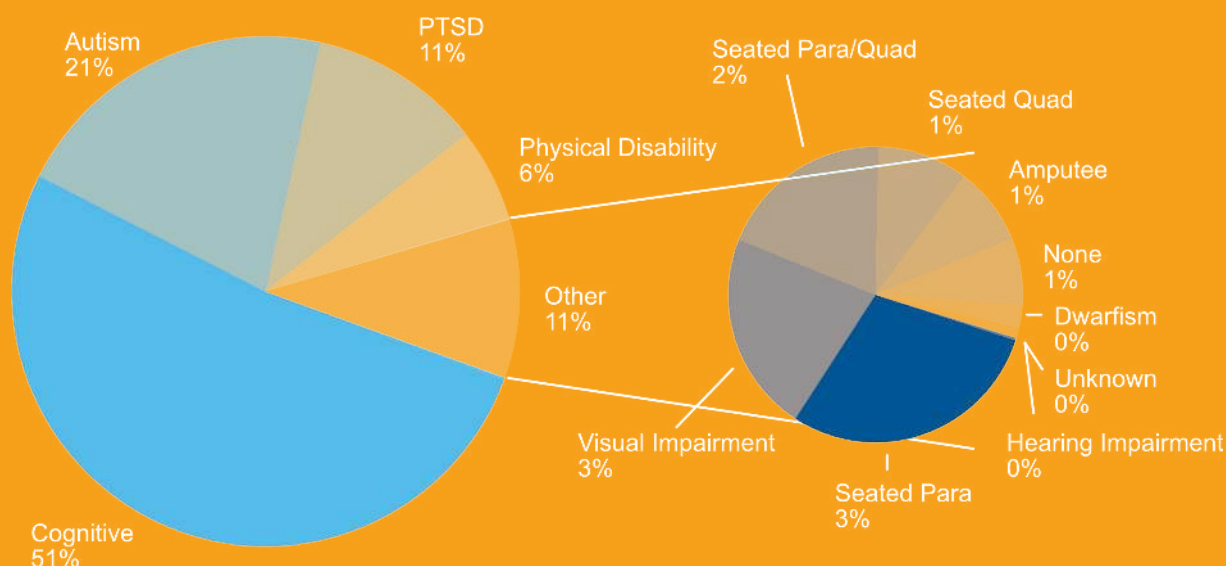
Our mission
